You are responsible for the information contained in class lectures, textbook assignments, the handouts and the atlas extra credit assignment. Also, the principles brought out during the entire course cannot be ignored and must be applied to any study of diffusion and land use.

The format is similar to Exams I and II. There will be multiple choice and true/false short answer questions, some of which will be aimed at a map and/or a diagram, and one essay. Know the map location of the **first 15 urban areas listed in the textbook on p. 448 and map p.446 (9th ed.) or p. 392 and map p. 393 (10th ed.)**. Also focus on the place names of physical features and countries for **Asia, Australia, and Oceania**. These will be presented as matching questions. ***For the list of countries, see the back of this page.***

In the essay, you will be asked to provide information to a client regarding a location analysis situation: siting an economic activity or discussion of a population issue or dealing with urbanization. To answer the question fully, you must discuss the points of the physical and human geography, the concepts of location analysis and geographic methodology used to assess a situation.
