A NOTE ABOUT THE LECTURE FORMAT
for an ASYNCHRONOUS COURSE

In the absence of in-person lecturing and face-to-face explanation of the material presented in the PowerPoint lecture slides, I will provide a written summary of the content of each lecture presentation, stressing the concepts and interrelationships that are essential to an introductory geography course. In essence, it is equivalent to giving you a transcript of my classroom lectures.

You will have access to the PowerPoint slides in two ways:

1. The presentation will be available in a six slide per page printable format (PDF). This format will preserve the hot links embedded in the slides and allow you to reach the sites included on some of the slides.
2. The presentation will be available in movie format (mp4) that preserves the automatic advancement, the dynamic graphics and the animations. You cannot save the individual slides here and the hot links are not active. You will need to go to the PDF version of the presentation to access the hot links.
