You need to submit a total of 10 required essays based on the formula listed on the assignment. Late submissions before the final due date (Monday, May 17) are better than a no submission at all = zero points. **Remember>>** Early submission of Part III essays allows you to revise and resubmit if there is a major problem with any essay. **Rushed writing = poor writing = lower grades.**
- **Think Geographically (TG) Extra Credit Essays.** These essays are based on the “Think Geographically” section at the end of each chapter. Select one discussion point from any five chapters (maximum of 5 TG may be submitted). See the posted instructions for details. Extra credit may not be turned in late and there is no option to revise/resubmit.
- **Other Extra Credit:** The deadline for a proposal submission has passed. **Any project submitted without my prior approval will not be graded.**
