## **End of Week Announcements.**

- The **fourteenth week** of the semester has come to an end. The academic week for GEOG 101-02 runs from Friday through Thursday.
- Lecture Progress. <u>Urban Geography Lecture 23</u> has been posted. Look over Chapter 10. This brings the instructional portion of the course to a close.
- Final Exam. The exam covering Part III of the course will be available on Friday, May 21 at 9 AM and shut down at 9 PM, Monday, May 24. The Study Guide for EXAM III will be posted on May 17.
- Required Assignments for Part III: They are due by 10 PM TONIGHT, Thursday, May 13, 2021. For Part III, you need to submit either 2, 3 or 4 essays from the list of options, depending how many you have already been submitted. You need to submit a total of 10 essays based on the formula listed in the syllabus. FOLLOW THE FORMAT. Each assignment must be freestanding with its own bibliography (don't combine bibliographic entries on one page). The bibliography may be placed immediately after each discussion -- no need to start it on a separate page.
- Rushed writing = poor writing = lower grades. The chief causes of point reductions for Parts I and II were:
  - not addressing the question (being off-topic)
  - leaving out a portion of the question (especially for multi-part questions)
  - answers that were too short (less than one page) or too general (not discussing the topic)
  - not following Presentation Guidelines (including not having opening and closing paragraphs, bibliography not in proper format, not indicating which question you are answering.)
- Deadline for Missing Required Essays. The last time to submit any missing required essays from Part I, Part II or Part III is 10 PM, Monday, May 17. Late penalty applies but it is better than a zero grade. No essay will be accepted starting 10:01 PM Monday, May 17, 2021 and a zero grade will be entered.
- Atlas Extra Credit III. The atlas extra credit for the final exam focuses on *Political Geography*, <u>Chapter 11</u> of the textbook. <u>The answer sheet is due by 11 PM TONIGHT</u>, <u>Thurs.</u>, <u>May 13<sup>th</sup></u>. Late submissions will not be graded. Be sure to use the <u>MSWord version</u> of the answer sheet which can be filled in, saved and attached to an email sent to me before the deadline.
- Think Geographically (TG) Extra Credit Essays. These optional essays for extra credit are based on the "Think Geographically" section at the end of each chapter. Select one discussion point from any five chapters (maximum of 5 TG may be submitted). See the posted instructions for details. Extra credit may not be turned in late and there is no option to revise/resubmit. NOTE: Because of my editing error on the Syllabus where two different

deadlines are listed, I will use the **later deadline of 10 PM Monday, May 17** for submission of TG Extra Credit chapter essays.

- Other Extra Credit: Any required essay topic that is in addition to 10 required essays (i.e., the 11<sup>th</sup> essay) will earn the same extra credit as a TG essay. The deadline for submission of a proposal for a special extra credit project submission has long passed. *Any project submitted without my prior approval will not be graded.*
