End of Week Announcements.

- Final Exam. Exam III covering Part III of the course will be available on Friday, May 21 at 9 AM and shut down at 9 PM, Monday, May 24. You will have 1½ hours for 100 questions.
- AccessABILITY Students. Those of you registered with the Hunter College Office of AccessABILITY and who wish to take advantage of the accommodations assigned to you, will be given a passcode for a special exam with a specific date and starting time.
 Those of you who did not contact me with a date/time will take the exam with the rest of the class without accommodation.
- Grades Posted. Grades for all the Required Assignments, TG and other extra credit essays, and Atlas Extra Credit have been posted on BlackBoard. A zero grade means either no points earned or assignment not submitted. It is too late to resubmit a "forgotten" or missed assignment. However, if you notice an error on your grade sheet, contact be immediately.
- Rushed writing = poor writing = lower grades. The chief causes of point reductions were:
 - not addressing the question (being off-topic)
 - leaving out a portion of the question (especially for multi-part questions)
 - answers that were too short (less than one page) or too general (not discussing the topic)
 - not following Presentation Guidelines (including not having opening and closing paragraphs, bibliography not in proper format, not indicating which question you are answering.)
- FINAL COURSE GRADE. Final grades will be posted next week on CUNYFirst. I need to manually add the extra credit to Exam III to get your score for the exam and then compute your final term average. No Incomplete (IN) grades will be given unless an arrangement was made with me in advance and documented proof submitted. Missed required work, including exams, are scored as a zero. CUNY/Hunter rules for grades, including CR/NC, WU and IN, are strictly followed.
