III. Recreational Activity (example of the tertiary or service sector)

B. Human Aspects

- 1. Population characteristics**, esp. attitude towards recreation, expendable income and leisure time
- 2. Perception (pull factors)**
- 3. Political and legal variables**
- 4. Amenities**

NOTE: *The quality of location changes with time:* markets change; people's attitudes and tastes change; new methods, technologies and procedures are developed; new supplies of material and labor force are found; supplies run out; markets disappear.
