## Literature Search

Due by no later than Oct. 18, 2012; late submission will be penalized.

The purpose of this exercise is to locate information about each of your counties in the news and scholarly media.

- 1. Using Google or another Internet search engine locate **one article** or posting of significance **for** <u>each</u> <u>county</u> assigned to you. Limit your search to the last 10 years. Sources may be a local or regional newspaper, an electric news forum or a professional or academic journal. You may also want to check the search engines available through Hunter's library: CUNY+, GEOBASE, GEOREF, SOCIAL EXPLORER and GOOGLE SCHOLAR for material in professional publications and academic journals.
- 2. Topics may include weather events, natural hazards, economic development, census data analysis, transportation issues, state and regional politics of a geographic nature, environmental issues, jobs and unemployment issues, NYS programs for development, and the like. Articles dealing with the historic perspective of places within the area may also be used.
- **3. Print** each article or posting selected. Be sure to include the **proper citations**.

**ASSIGNMENT:** (a) Provide a summary of the essence of each article or posting **in geographic terms** using the *Five Fundamental Themes of Geography* as the guide. So in addition to summarizing the theme of the article or posting, ask yourself: "Where's the geography?" and then (b) describe how it is embedded. Each article needs to have at least one theme addressed. Attach the 3 articles to your analysis.
