## Final exam. Q 2

## Write an essay explaining the factors that affect the distribution of the African population. Give at least 4 examples from peer reviewed journals.

- Many areas of the continent are sparsely settled (less than 4 persons per sq. km). In contrast, Latin America is 9 persons/sq. km.
- Distribution of population is influenced by many factors:
- Environmental (i.e. deserts and swampy areas), political and social factors.
- **Amounts of precipitation** are the most important climatic factors in population distribution.
- Low population densities are associated with low amounts of rainfall.
- On those areas drought and desertification are becoming major problems for African development.
- If there is **no economic investment** such as oil, mineral, agriculture, water supply in these semi-arid desertified areas it will remain undeveloped (i.e. Bushmen in South Africa).
- On the other hand, areas of tropical rain forest which receives high amounts of rainfall have low population densities because of the infertile soils.
- Pockets of volcanic soils "Rwanda and Burundi" are densely populated.
- Low lands with **alluvial soils** (which are valleys with rich clay soils such as Gambia, Senegal and the Nile rivers) are **density populated areas.**
- In marginal areas (semi-arid climate) and where manures (animal fertilizer), intercropping, replanting and crop diversity can support high density of population (i.e. Kano region in Nigeria).
- Deadly diseases (sleeping sickness which caused by Tse Tse fly and river blindness (N. Ghana) in some part of the Savanna and tropical forest are factors of low population density in areas with rich soils.
- **Historically**, slave trade affects the middle belt of W. Africa.
- It was estimated that the cross Atlantic slave trade reduced African population by **one-third.**
- On the other hand, high areas such as **Jos Plateau** have high density of population because it served as **defensive area from the slave trade.**
