



Encouraged economic activity and allowed a profit to be made (money-oriented economy).




Manufacturing

- The <u>factory system</u> focused industry on cities.
- Factory manufacturing is set to a specific site.
- What does a manufacturing activity need?
 - It needs workers.
- It needs **access** to raw materials, power and markets.

- It needs financial backing (lines of credit/loans/insurance).







Manufacturing and Social Order

Change to factory manufacturing saw:


- a. The emergence of a new middle class: factory workers had more disposable income and leisure time.
- b. Changes in the social order evolved: the roles of family, gender and religion.
- c. Fundamental changes in society, culture and politics resulted, esp. in industrial cities.
- Labor unions were formed; protests and strikes occurred; law-makers were lobbied; unions became powerful politically.
- e. In NYS these factors lead to the beginnings of the women's rights, social reform, and worker's rights movements.




Labor and Social Reforms

- Social reform movements, esp. those dealing with the ills of urban areas, were started in NYS.
- Working class neighborhoods grew near factories. They soon became crowded and polluted. Living conditions were bad.
- Wealthy moved away from work ing districts.
- NYC became the focus of the social reform movements, esp. housing and social welfare. Jacob Riis is a noted NYC activist.
